- **BIO-WARFARE AGENTS**

In 2001, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) unveiled plans to collocate advanced biological warfare agent research with nuclear weapons at its Livermore (CA) and Los Alamos (NM) weapons design laboratories. The DOE plan involves genetically modifying bioweapon agents at Livermore Lab as well as conducting aerosol (spray) experiments on up to 100 small animals at a time.

Tri-Valley CAREs works to prevent the DOE from mixing bugs and bombs, including with litigation in 2003 and 2008, which came to a close in 2012. Our efforts seek to protect workers and the public from accidents, spills and releases while simultaneously strengthening domestic regulations, the Biological Weapons Convention, the international treaty banning bioweapons.

- **NAVY WARFARE TRAINING & TESTING**

The U.S. Navy has announced its decision to implement its Preferred Alternative (Alternative 1) to conduct military readiness training and testing activities primarily within existing range complexes, operating areas and testing ranges of the Northwest Training and Testing Study Area.

Environmental Voices and other activists have unsuccessfully opposed the expansion of this program for many years because of the toxic chemicals that will be released in the ocean and environment. In addition, there will be millions of marine animals exposed to harm which may cause death.
